

## Volunteer Requirements

### For all volunteers:

- You are not now and have never been a batterer, perpetrator of sexual assault, or a child abuser.
- You have a commitment to working with survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault.
- You agree to abide by the SAFE House confidentiality policy, which states that all information about survivors and their children is strictly confidential. You may not confirm *or* deny that someone is receiving services from SAFE House.
- You will follow all rules and regulations regarding security and safety at SAFE House.
- You agree to a criminal background check through the Michigan State Police.

### For ongoing, crisis intervention volunteers:

- ***You agree to attend all 40 hours of training.***
- You commit to volunteer for at least six months.
- You will attend at least half of volunteer in-services.
- You commit to a regular number of hours per week, which will be determined with your coordinator.

### For as-needed, project-based, one-time and other volunteers:

- You agree to attend a four hour orientation training (additionally, Kitchen Moms will be asked to attend a supplemental kitchen training for approximately two hours).
- You will seek approval from SAFE House staff for all work that you do on our behalf (for example, any donation solicitation will be coordinated with our Resource Development staff).
