Dear Community

Twenty-four hours a day, 7 days a week, the staff and volunteers of SafeHouse Center's Response Teams answer calls from police and hospitals. Every day of the year, you'll find us in hospital rooms, doctor's offices, survivor's homes and jails – offering hope and safety to survivors of sexual assault and domestic violence. In a typical year, the Response Teams provide essential information and crisis intervention services to nearly 800 survivors in Washtenaw County.

Domestic Violence Response Team (DVRT) staff and volunteers provide immediate, on-site support. They also meet with survivors who have been hospitalized due to an assault or who report a past assault. Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) staff and volunteers provide crisis intervention and support to survivors, ages 16 and up, immediately following a sexual assault.

Most individuals first learn of SafeHouse Center through contact with our Response Teams. For many, it is their initial point of entry to our services.

Given the fear and stigma many survivors feel, it is imperative that we reach them quickly. Therein lies the strength of the Response Team program. SafeHouse Center goes to the survivor immediately, assuring that she will receive information and help at the most critical time following an assault. What's more, by working with area hospitals, law enforcement and prosecutors, we have been able to streamline processes and improve services to survivors in our community.

SafeHouse Center is one of the few agencies in our community that provides 24/7 services, not only through our shelter and HelpLine, but through our critical outreach into the community. We are here for survivors, whatever the time, wherever the call. That's why, although we provide many other services, in this issue we are highlighting our Response Team program.

I encourage you to take part in this important effort.

There are many ways you can "Help Us Change the Numbers." Your financial support ensures that we will remain available and in the community 24 hours a day. Your volunteer efforts allow us to maintain the level of service survivors and their children need and deserve. Your commitment to speak out against domestic violence and sexual assault informs others that these acts of violence will not be tolerated.

Together, we will continue to be there for those who need us.

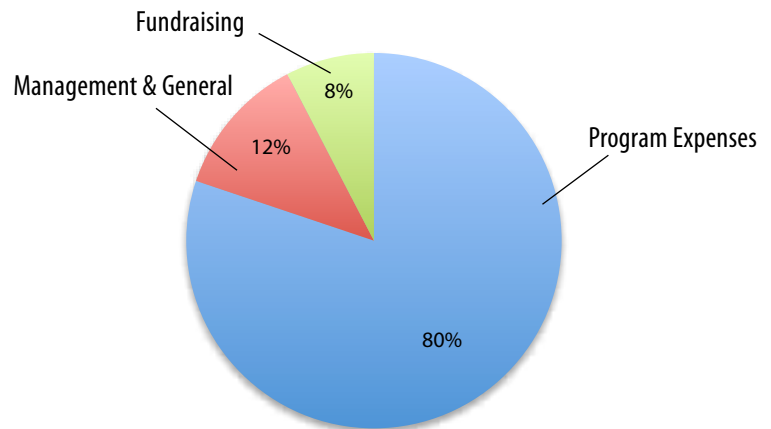
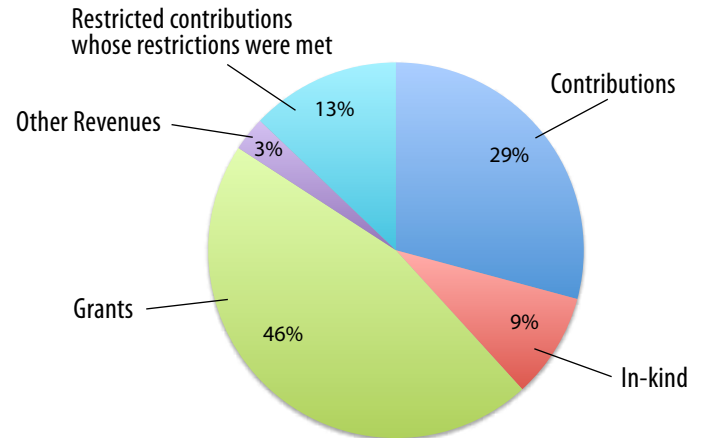

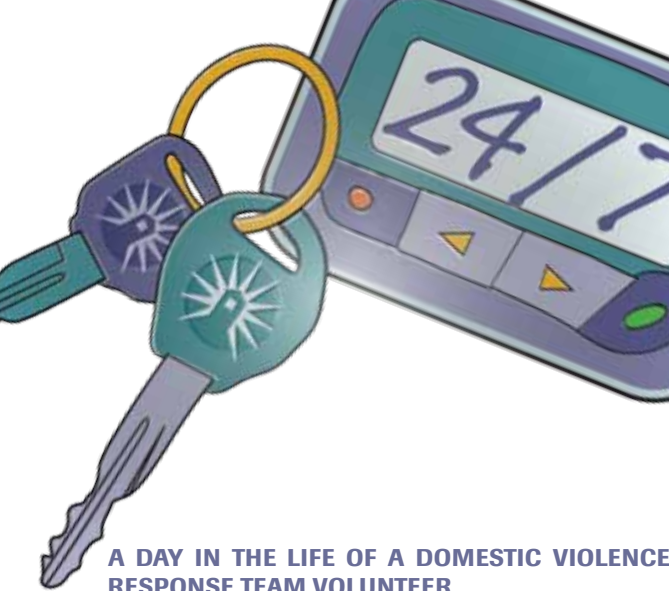

A DAY IN THE LIFE OF A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESPONSE TEAM VOLUNTEER

8:00 a.m. Pick up the DVRT (Domestic Violence Response Team) pager at SafeHouse Center. On call for the next 24 hours....

8:15 a.m. My pager goes off. It's the person who was on call the night before, alerting me that there is a survivor in the hospital, someone they were unable to see early this morning.

8:20 a.m. Drive to the hospital. Spend the next two hours with the survivor, listening, telling her about the services we offer at SafeHouse Center. Her assault was especially violent, and she is afraid to return home. I let her know about our safe shelter and how to call for a shelter assessment.

10:30 a.m. Back to SafeHouse Center. Do follow-up paperwork and contact the shelter to let them know that the survivor I just saw may be calling. Pager goes off twice in the next hour with calls from walk-in survivors. One will be seen by the SART (Sexual Assault Response Team) responder. I will work with the other survivor.

11:30 a.m. Meet with the walk-in. She was referred to SafeHouse Center by another community agency that provides her with food assistance. She and her partner had an argument the evening before and she is beginning to realize that the relationship is abusive. She wants to talk about her options so I spend time with her, assessing her needs. I tell her about our support groups and counseling services. We spend an extensive amount of time on safety planning. When she is ready to leave, I give her a Survivor's Handbook and information about the next steps she needs to take if she would like future counseling sessions.

12:15 p.m. Three pages in a row with jail release alerts. The jail supplies the names of the survivors who may be affected by these releases. I attempt to contact the survivors to let them know the assailants have been released.

12:30 p.m. Although we try not to schedule counseling appointments when we have a Response Team shift, sometimes survivors are unable to come at a different time, so we make every effort to see them. My standing appointment arrives as I finish contacting the survivors about jail releases.

2:00 p.m. Start paperwork for the earlier contacts. A survivor walks in and I am paged. Her ex-husband has been stalking her and has threatened to kill her and their children. She is seeking a Personal Protection Order (PPO) to protect herself and her family. PPO requests need to be filed by 4:30 p.m., so I work with her to complete the paperwork. Then I deliver the forms to the City Clerk's office since the survivor has traveled by bus and can't make it to the Clerk's office in time.

4:30 p.m. As I drive back to SafeHouse Center, the pager rings again. A new walk-in is concerned not only for her own safety but for the safety of her teenage son as well. Although they have left the abusive relationship, she needs help with next steps and feels her son also needs supportive services. I return to SafeHouse Center, work with her to secure an appointment for her son at Ozone House, and give her the information she needs to join our drop-in support group.

5:00 p.m. I talk with my Response Team partner, who will be on call with me from now until 8:00 a.m. tomorrow. During the day, a SafeHouse Center staff member responds to pages. During the evening and overnight hours, we partner with another staff member or with a volunteer.

5:30 p.m. I complete the day's paperwork and head home.

7:00 p.m. My pager goes off. The police have made an arrest. We go to the survivor's home to provide her with information about our services, then talk with her for a couple of hours until the pager goes off again.

9:00 p.m. A law enforcement officer contacts us with a report a woman has been arrested. When police responded to the call, the husband had scratches on his face.

9:15 p.m. We visit the woman in jail. She reports that she scratched her husband while he was strangling her. She currently has no visible marks, as the bruises won't show for a few more hours. We discuss the history of the relationship and assess her as being a survivor and eligible for our services. We leave information for her.

Midnight We receive three more jail release calls and contact those survivors whose information has been provided by law enforcement officials.

3:00 a.m. Pager goes off. The hospital is calling us about a survivor who has been badly beaten by her boyfriend. We visit but can only talk to her sporadically as health care staffers are in and out, stitching her wounds and determining the severity of a head injury. We leave information with the survivor.

8:00 a.m. To SafeHouse Center, where I hand off my pager to the next Response Team member. While we are debriefing about pager activity, a survivor arrives who speaks only Spanish. We contact our Spanish-speaking advocate to assist her.

9:00 a.m. My scheduled appointment arrives and I start my new day. Today, it's someone else's turn to respond to the pager. And so the process continues, providing critical outreach to members of our community...
